

Explanations and FAQs

- The Total Allocations in Maryland pie chart on the main page represents all allocations that Maryland has received to date through 1512 grants, and through increased federal contributions to formula-funded programs. The Education slice includes allocations to the Maryland State Department of Education, as well as to the University System of Maryland, which are shown on the map.
- The “Total Allocations in Maryland” map includes allocations to date, as well as the amount of money that has been sub-allocated to jurisdictions and project level data. The sub-allocations in each jurisdiction will match the allocations shown on the “County Specific Investments” map.
- If you were to add up each the sub allocations in each county by spending category as found on the County Specific Investments map, the total would be smaller than that on the Total Allocations pie on the main Recovery page and the pie on the Total Allocations in Maryland map. The reason is that the County map only includes funding that has been sub-allocated to jurisdictions. Some spending categories on the map include administrative funds that are to be used centrally within the State agency.
- The Recovery Jobs data is calculated using direct jobs and quarterly expenditure data from grants and formula funding. The Department of Business and Economic Development inputs the data into an IMPLAN model, which uses multipliers to estimate the economic impact of each spending category based on the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS). The outputs are indirect and induced jobs.
- Previously, we were counting anticipated awards in the Transportation category. To make this category more consistent with the others, we are now only counting 1512 MTA, SHA, MPA, and BWI awards as well as WMATA data in the Transportation category. Transportation allocations will increase once the anticipated awards are made.
- The maps and pie chart will be updates on a quarterly basis after each reporting period. Transportation, Housing, Energy, and Education may be updated on a more regular basis.
